MEETING NOTES

Meeting #5 Tuesday, December 10, 2019 Northwest High School

1. WELCOME

Assistant Superintendent Tim McClure welcomed the committee and reviewed the meeting agenda with the group.

2. MEETING #4 RECAP

Assistant Superintendent Tim McClure reviewed the bonding capacity, survey results and potential projects with the group.

3. ADDITIONAL PROJECT CONSIDERATIONS

Assistant Superintendent Tim McClure discussed a new development in Wise County that the Dallas Morning News reported on and showed a slide from Templeton Demographics that outlines the area where the development is planned.

He also gave an overview of additional projects that have been discussed since the committee last met. These include a replacement campus for Pike Middle School, and a concept for a long-term master plan for the district's central campus. Projects would include a new road, or main thoroughfare, through the campus from traffic light to traffic light; relocating the Support Services Building (DAEP, support services offices, maintenance facility, etc.); relocating the transportation facility, constructing a replacement campus for Pike and repurposing Hatfield Elementary School. This would allow space in the future for a district events center, a community area and appropriately positioned support facilities.

4. PRIORITIZATION ACTIVITY

Committee members spent the majority of the meeting in small groups working through a prioritization exercise where they ranked each potential project against a set of factors.
